PHL Responds to Temporary Restraining Order

PHILADELPHIA – At Philadelphia International Airport, the international arrivals area is under federal jurisdiction with U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) providing security and facilitation operations.

In accordance with the Temporary Restraining Order issued by a judge in Washington state, CBP has returned to its operating procedures as they were prior to the signing of the EO last Friday, January 27. It is the Airport's understanding that all directors within CBP have been notified of the immediate change.

The Airport welcomes the return of operating procedures in which properly vetted foreign travelers and refugees are admitted into the United States.
