## Frontier Airlines Announces New Service to San Juan

**PHILADELPHIA, PA** – Frontier Airlines announced today that it will begin non-stop flights between Philadelphia International Airport (PHL) and San Juan, Puerto Rico (SJU) starting in June, continuing the "Ultra Low Cost Carrier's" expansion in Philadelphia. The PHL-SJU flights are scheduled to operate year-round.

"We are very excited that Frontier will be offering non-stop service from Philadelphia to San Juan, which is popular destination for both tourists and natives of Puerto Rico who travel back home to visit," said Airport CEO Chellie Cameron. "We are pleased that Frontier continues to bring new service to Philadelphia and look forward to even more flights to more places."

San Juan will become Frontier's 20<sup>th</sup> non-stop destination from PHL. Nineteen of the destinations, which are served with a mix of year-round and seasonal service, have been added since December 2014. Frontier is the only carrier at PHL that offers non-stop flights to San Antonio, Texas; and Punta Gorda, Florida. Those flights operate seasonally.

Currently, American Airlines provides non-stop flights from PHL to San Juan.

"Our network continues to expand in markets where people want to fly," said Josh Flyr, Frontier Vice President, Network Planning. "And customers in Philadelphia, with the addition of San Juan, Puerto Rico, now have a low-cost option to 20 destinations."

The PHL-SJU route will be served with A-321 aircraft.
